Data Privacy. According to the Minnesota Government Data Practices Act, library users must be informed of what private data is being collected, its uses and disposition (sometimes referred to as the “Tennessee warning”). By Minnesota law, information you provide in applying for a library card, except your name, as well as information which links your name with library materials is private. It is available only to you and to appropriate library personnel. This information is required to support library services. You are not legally required to provide the information on the application, but you will not receive a library card if you do not fill out the information on the application. The information in the application must be released pursuant to a court order.
